Location : Py-Mantet private mountains, in the Pyrénées-Orientales (above 6,500 ft altitude)

Benefits of hunting: Get as close as possible to the animals and optimize your chances of multiplying

spot and stalk and sharing a campfire atmosphere.

♣ Schedule of the trip: Day 1 - Hiking to hunting zone and setting up of the camp.

Day 2 & 3 - Hunting from sunrise until nightfall.

Day 4 - Packing out the camp and return.

In this Bivouac formula, Catalhunt provides the tents (excluding sleeping bags) and covers all meals during the stay.

HUNTING WILD BOAR IN THE SNOW (JANUARY / FEBRUARY ONLY)

WILD BOAR

Location: Py-Mantet private mountains, in the Pyrénées-Orientales (above 6,500 ft altitude)

Benefits of the hunt: Spot and stalk on our mountain wild boars in the snow, snowshoes on,

will remain an unforgettable moment just like the crackling of the fireplace in the evening

at the cabin.

Schedule of the trip: Day 1 - Hike to the refuge area in snowshoes, skis or crawler quad.

Day 2 & 3 - Hunting from sunrise until nightfall.

Day 4 - Pack out and return.

This formula is including all meals provided by Catalhunt during the stay.

| Bow

Bow with a minimum poundage of 60 lbs with optimal setup for mountain hunting and the ability of shooting a lethal shot at 55 yards.



| Backpack

A minimum 30 L backpack in order to be able to carry your water bottle, food and clothing.

A waterproof and windproof jacket.



Inspection of equipment and target shooting before the start of the hunt.

For French hunters only: must present a copy of a membership and card from an archery club affiliated to the French Archery Federation (FFTA).

QUESTIONS / ANSWERS

- ♣ I am not very athletic to hike in the mountains, do I have the profile for this type of hunting?
 - Catalhunt will make every effort to adapt the hunt you have chosen to your physical condition.
 - However, the latter may dictate the choice of the type of hunting and territory.
- What happens in the event of bad weather during my stay?
 - Catalhunt reserves the right to adapt the type of hunting, accommodation and territory according to the weather conditions.
 - The rain, the snow, and the fog do not prevent us from hunting.
 - Even if the Pyrénées-Orientales benefit from a Mediterranean dry climate with optimal sunshine and autumn is usually a beautiful season but severe weather can occur due to the geographical location of the moutain range.
- ➡ What validation of the hunting license should I have ?
 - Our 25 territories being located in several departments, we recommend the national validation of the permit of hunting.
 - However, Catalhunt has the documents to obtain the departmental validation quickly.
 - The cost of this permit will then be invoiced to you.
- → How long does a stay last ?
 - The average duration of our stays is 2 full hunting days (excluding arrival and departure). Depending on the animals hunted, you can extend the initial stay, subject to Catalhunt availability.
- ♣ Is it possible to hunt multiple animals?
 - Catalhunt will adapt as well as possible to your requirements and will do everything possible to optimize the hunting opportunities on multiple species during your stay.
- ♣ If I wound an animal, what do we do ?
 - A bad shot can happen and if you wound an animal, we will do our best to try to find it with the help of a blood dog.
 - If, however, the injury is not found to be lethal, you may continue your hunt.
 - On the other hand, if the wound is sufficiently serious and the animal is judged to be dead but not found by your guide, you will have to pay the tag at full price.
- Can you prepare the trophies?
 - After the hunt, we can prepare the skin or the whole animal for you if you wish to have taxidermy done on it.
 - We work with a local taxidermist, who is perfectly familiar with the attitude of the emblematic game animals of our region.
 - If you only want to keep the european mount, the Catalhunt team can prepare that for you as well.
 - You will then be charged an additional cost.
- → What caliber of rifle and ammunition should I use to hunt in the mountains?
 - During your hunting trip, you will be required to shoot at very close distances, as well as at rather long distances.
 - Your rifle should be perfectly adjusted to the DRO of the ammunition used. You will need to adapt the type of bullet to the game you want to shoot. For example, in the case of an isard hunt, do not use too hard of warheads but plan instead for rapidly expanding warheads (ballistic tip, tipstrike, SST ...).

➡ What type of weapon can I rent ?

♣ Where can we stay during our stay?

Catalhunt has a network of hotels / lodges that can accommodate you. By contacting us, we will be able to show you the list of accommodations all around your next hunting location.

You will also have the possibility of staying as close as possible to our hunting grounds in the house of Mantet but also in the refuge in the heart of the Py-Mantet private mountains. You will then be autonomous and you will have to come with your meals and cook them yourself.

Mantet House - accommodation capacity 8 people with 3 bathrooms, kitchen, TV area and washing machine.











"Le refuge" (cabin) - accommodation capacity is 5 people with electricity, running water, bathroom, WC, stove and fireplace.
